Entergy Gulf States Louisiana, L.L.C. and Entergy Louisiana, LLC, ex parte. In re: Joint Application for approval of an increase in funding for decommissioning for River Bend and Waterford 3 Nuclear Facilities.

The Louisiana Public Service Commission (“Commission” or “LPSC”), in accordance with the requirements of the LPSC’s General Order dated August 4, 2004, regarding the selection of contract employees to represent the Commission, (“Contract Order”) issues this Request for Proposals (“RFP”) to independent technical consultants which will assist the Commission in reviewing the technical and jurisdictional issues related to the Commission review of the above referenced Application which was published in the Commission’s Official Bulletin dated January 8, 2010. The Commission reserves the right to reject any proposal or decline to undertake these reviews at this time.

I. Overview

Entergy Louisiana, LLC (“ELL”) and Entergy Gulf States Louisiana, L.L.C. (“EGSL”) (collectively, the “Companies”) filed an application on December 29, 2009 seeking approval to provide supplemental funding for the decommissioning trusts maintain for the Commission’s jurisdictional portions of the Waterford 3 nuclear generating facility, owned by ELL and the Riverbend nuclear generating facility owned by EGSL. The request to increase respective revenue requirements is to address projected shortfalls found by the Nuclear Regulatory Commission in the decommissioning funding assurance required for each facility. The application can be viewed on the LPSC’s web site at www.lpsc.org.

II. Scope of Representation

Applicants will be assisting Staff by reviewing the Application, including the testimony filed by the Companies in support thereof. The applicant will be expected to assist in the preparation of discovery and other tasks normally associated with the evaluation and pre-hearing process, prepare and defend direct testimony on each of the transactions, participate in certification hearings, and make recommendations to the Commission. Applicants will also be assisting Staff in preparation of any post-hearing briefs or filings, assisting in any settlement discussions, mediations, and/or stipulation hearings and attendance and testifying at the Commission’s Business and Executive Session.

Applicants must be familiar with the Commission’s Orders regarding the Formula Rate Plans of both ELL and EGSL; any other relevant LPSC Orders; general electric utility ratemaking and rate design principles; and be able to make a determination regarding the appropriate amount of recovery and recovery mechanism to be used.

III. Period of Representation

The time period (“Period of Representation”) estimated to complete the Scope of representation is approximately 12-18 months. This is merely an estimate and the Commission makes no representations as to the accuracy of the Period of Representation.

IV. Minimum Requirements

To be considered, all applicants must meet the following minimum requirements *in addition to those provided in* this Commission’s General Order dated August 4, 2004. Consideration will be given to factors such as educational background and achievement, practical experience in the field of public utility practice, and similar practice before other state public utility commissions.

Applicant shall be qualified and prepared to draft and render expert testimony, and be cross-examined with respect to all of the issues addressed in this RFP and which are likely to arise in the proceeding. Applicant shall have a full understanding and ability to analyze the relief sought by the Companies in the Application. Applicant shall, at a minimum, be experienced in analyzing the operations, books and records of utility companies and be qualified and prepared to render expert testimony regarding and have knowledge of: Louisiana Public Service Commission ratemaking and jurisdictional issues; familiarity with and experience in dealing with affiliate transactions and cost sharing among company affiliates, particularly with the Entergy System Agreement; experience in all aspects of electric utility retail

ratemaking proceedings and periodic rate review proceedings; and knowledge of appropriate accounting standards and practices for electric utilities.

All proposals shall include a plan of action, estimated timeline, and fees and costs associated with evaluation of the application. This will result in one proposal. However, in the event, an applicant is chosen, the Commission and its Staff shall have the right to determine how the tasks will be carried out. In addition, all proposals shall demonstrate that the Applicant has the qualifications and experience necessary to meet the requirements of this RFP. Applicants will only be considered if proposals meet all of the requirements of this RFP and the Commission's Contract Order.

V. Estimate of Cost

All applicants responding to the Request for Proposal shall quote their rates on an hourly basis and shall also submit a total budget, which shall separate professional fees from costs. However, applicants shall only be allowed to charge for actual hours of work performed and costs incurred. Once selected, an applicant's rates and budget shall not be altered except by formal approval of the Commission.

VI. Conflict of Interest

Previous or current employment which could result in a conflict of interest shall be prominently and separately disclosed. In addition, applicants shall disclose matters in which they currently represent private clients before the Commission.

VII. Disclaimer

The LPSC reserves the right to reject any and all proposals, to amend and/ or supplement this RFP at any time, and to consider proposals or modifications thereof received at any time prior to LPSC vote at Open Session, if such action is found by the LPSC to be in the public interest. Pursuant to the General Order regarding the selection of contract employees, the LPSC has the right to accept other than the lowest offer with regard to price. In addition, there is also no assurance, express or implied, that an award will necessarily be made pursuant to this RFP.

Billing Guidelines

As required by the August 4, 2004 General Order, all bills will be rendered monthly and shall specifically identify and describe all work performed, the person performing such work, the time and charge for such work, and shall additionally show the total amount billed to date and the authorized original estimate. Bills will be rendered in strict accordance with the Commission's guidelines. Expenses shall also be separately disclosed with proof of such expenses attached.

Expenses, where applicable, shall be reimbursed at state authorized rates as specified in the Travel Policies and Procedures Memorandum issued by the State of Louisiana, Division of Administration in effect at the time such expenses are incurred ("Allowable Expenses"). Any expenses that exceed the Allowable Expenses shall be borne by the contract employee and shall not be reimbursed by either the Commission, or the correspondent utility, unless otherwise specified by the Commission.
